








trail rules

>Stay on the trail at all times - Pay attention and obey trail signs and markings.

- >Avoid making loud noises.
- >Respect Private Property.
- >Do not litter. Take all litter with you and place in rubbish bins.
- >Be careful with livestock. Do not disturb animals.
- >Preserve nature. Do not pick flowers, collect rocks or catch animals.
- >Avoid walking alone in the mountains. >Be careful when foggy.
- >Always use appropriate gear and clothing - hiking boats, a raincoat and a hat.
- >Do not make fire at any time.
- >Help preserve the trail.



trail description PR2

This circular trail starts off in the centre of Montaria, next to the Porta do Sítio da Serra d'Arga (Interpretation Centre) and heads towards Montaria Parish Church and Calvary. Along the way you may visit the Costa Mill, a characteristic symbol of the Montaria landscape along with the paths and levadas (irrigation channels).

These confer a very pictures que setting to the landscape. These irrigation channels are still in use today. Continue on a shepherd's trail and about 1 km ahead you will come to a military road that will lead you to the "Santa Justa" Chapel and shelters (this belongs to the Ponte de Lima region). This place is quite interesting due to its imposing walls, the dimensions of the shelter and the singularity of the chapel. The trail heads towards "Lugar do Cerquido", in the village of Estorãos - the stone pavement heads towards the Senhora do Minho plateau, where you may visit a small cave with a stone statue of Our Lady wearing a Minhoto costume (traditional folk costume). You may also contemplate the views over the regions of Paredes de Coura, Ponte de Lima and Viana do Castelo, the Lima river valley as well as the majestic Atlantic Ocean.

The trail now descends to Montaria, passing the Porta da Vila, an odd stone (granite) formation which received this name as it looks like a door, as well as an old house located right in the middle of the mountain.
